



NJPEA Show Rules

(Amended January 2010)

1. The horse's registration papers and a current Coggins Test (NJ allows a 2 year test, out of state requires a current year test) must be presented at the show office. OUT OF STATE HORSES must also have a current Health Certificate.
2. All owners and exhibitors must be members of PHBA in order to show.
3. The Show Committee has the right to combine or cancel classes pending the number of entries.
4. Any class can be added by request if entries warrant.
5. Exhibitors **MUST scratch classes with the appropriate Scratch/Add form, 3 classes prior** to the class being held to avoid being charged for that class.
6. The Show Committee reserves the right to excuse unruly horses from the ring. Any undue restraint or punishment to an animal by an exhibitor/owner/trainer is prohibited. The exhibitor/owner/trainer may be excused from the show ring or the showground if the behavior persists. Stabling of horses in horse trailers overnight is prohibited by NJ State Law.
7. Any objections should be reported to the Ring Steward or Show Secretary; NO exhibitor shall approach the judges directly.
8. Entry forms must be filled out completely. NJPEA will not be held responsible for point reporting errors with PHBA due to incomplete forms.
9. Any conflicts will be referred to the current PHBA rulebook.
10. Any exhibitor or their horse that damages a stall panel will incur a fee as assessed by the Horse Park.
11. Any exhibitor that damages a hookup, plug, electrical outlet or water spigot will be charged a fee as assessed by the Horse Park.
12. NJ Horse Park strictly enforces the early arrival fee of \$100 and \$25 per horse if you arrive before 12 Noon the day before the first day of the show. You must call Martha Hoff at 732-236-4623 to make arrangements if you plan on arriving early.

Circuit Awards

Awards for Circuit Champion and Reserve Circuit Champion will be awarded as follows:

Stallions, Mares, Geldings, Youth 5-9, 13 & Under, 14 & Over, Novice Youth, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Select Amateur, Western Performance Horse, English Performance Horse (see below for eligible classes), Open Speed, Open Color, Youth Color and Amateur Color. You must show under ALL judges to be eligible for Circuit Awards. Each Division MUST hold 3 classes each day to earn a Circuit Award. For Performance awards you MUST show in a minimum of 1 halter class for the total circuit in your respective division (Color class does not count toward the halter class requirement). The Show Secretary will tally points and the results will be final.

Show Fees

PER Class fee: \$8.00 per judge for Open & Amateur; Youth \$6.00 per judge.

Walk/Jog 5-9 year olds \$5.00 per judge (Walk/Jog Day Fee \$50.00 – All Judges per day).

All Day show fees (per judge/horse): \$50.00 Open & Amateur, \$45.00 for youth.

NEW! All day back number fee \$75.00 per judge (one horse with any rider in any class).

Cross Over Fee (Youth to Open) (Amateur to Open) \$35.00 per judge.

PHBA Computer and Drug Free is \$5.00 per judge/day

NJPEA Office Fee is \$4.00 per judge/day
